Are you **independent** in nature and tend to self-motivate rather than seek guidance from peers and colleagues? If so, you may relate most to the **PANTHER.**




Do you consider yourself to be a nurturing peacekeeper who places high importance on **relationship building**? The strong but supportive **ELEPHANT** may be your closest match.
